3) Management of the reserve list and appeal procedure

The candidates on the "Reserve List" can receive an EM-scholarship only in case of withdrawal of a candidate of the "Main List". The replacement of a "Main List" candidate by a "Reserve List" can be done only if she or he is replaced by the first eligible candidate on the Reserve List. In this case, it should be considered that there is an EMJMD condition concerning the nationality of the reserve list candidate and the rule as regards the presence of maximum three nationals from the same country among the scholarship holders for a given category of students (Programme / Partner Country). If there are already three other students with the same nationality on the Main List, the emiSS consortium will have to take the next eligible candidate respecting its own ranking list. Also, the gender balance should be considered. Some of the candidates in the Reserve List, who have mentioned the fact they have self-funding possibilities in the application form, can be replaced with a candidate by the emiSS Executive Board in case of withdrawal of a candidate in the "Self-funded List".

## 4) Appeal procedure

When you receive the selection result, please do not contact the emiSS Executive Board concerning the results. If you want to appeal against the selection decision, please read the Admission Requirements, the Selection Procedure and Evaluation Grid given under the General Information in emiSS webpage. If candidates followed the application procedure and respected the deadlines but were denied selection due to unmet selection criteria, and have reasons to believe that there is a mistake during the selection procedure, they have the right to appeal the Selection Board's decision by email to emiSS@omu.edu.tr within 48 hours after the results announced.
